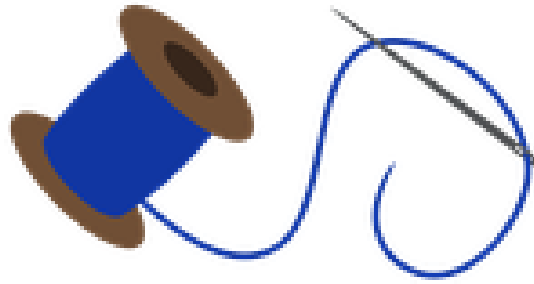

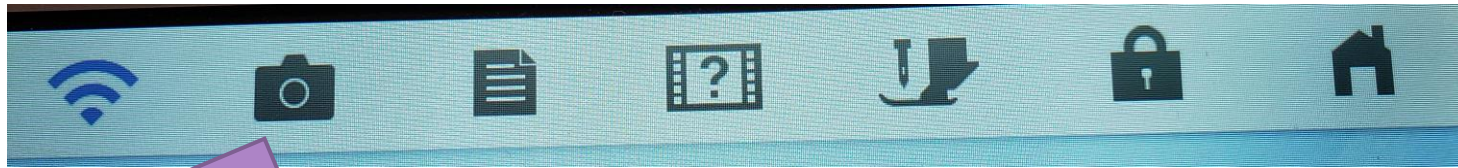

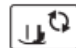

Presser foot/Needle exchange key 

Press before changing the needle, the presser foot, etc. This key locks all key and button functions to prevent operation of the machine.

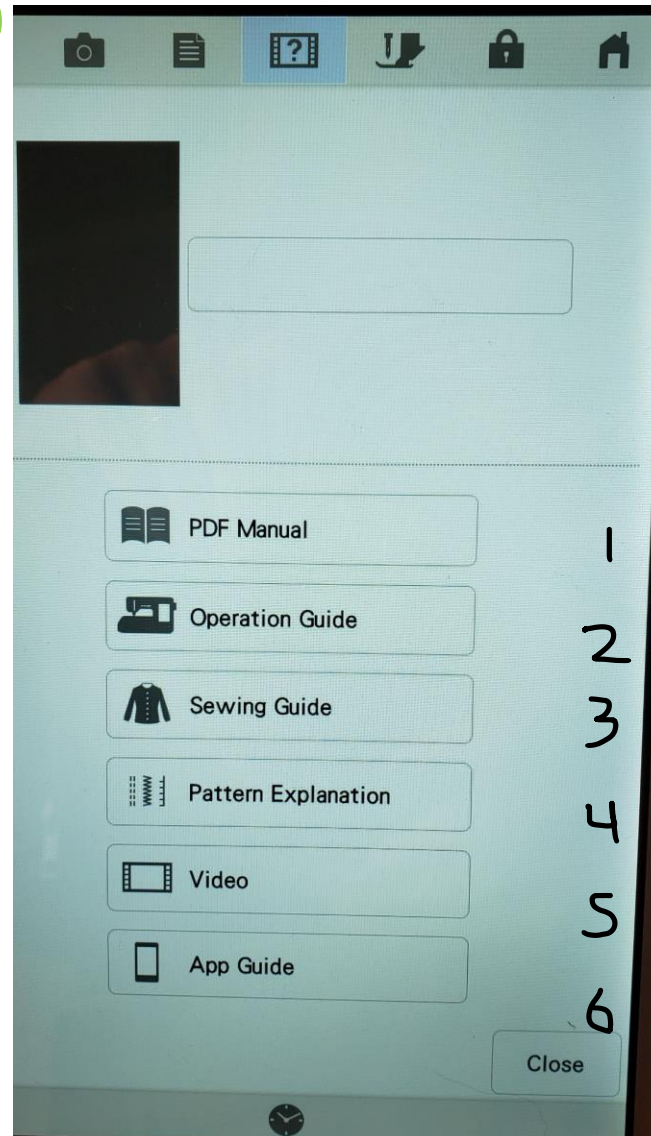

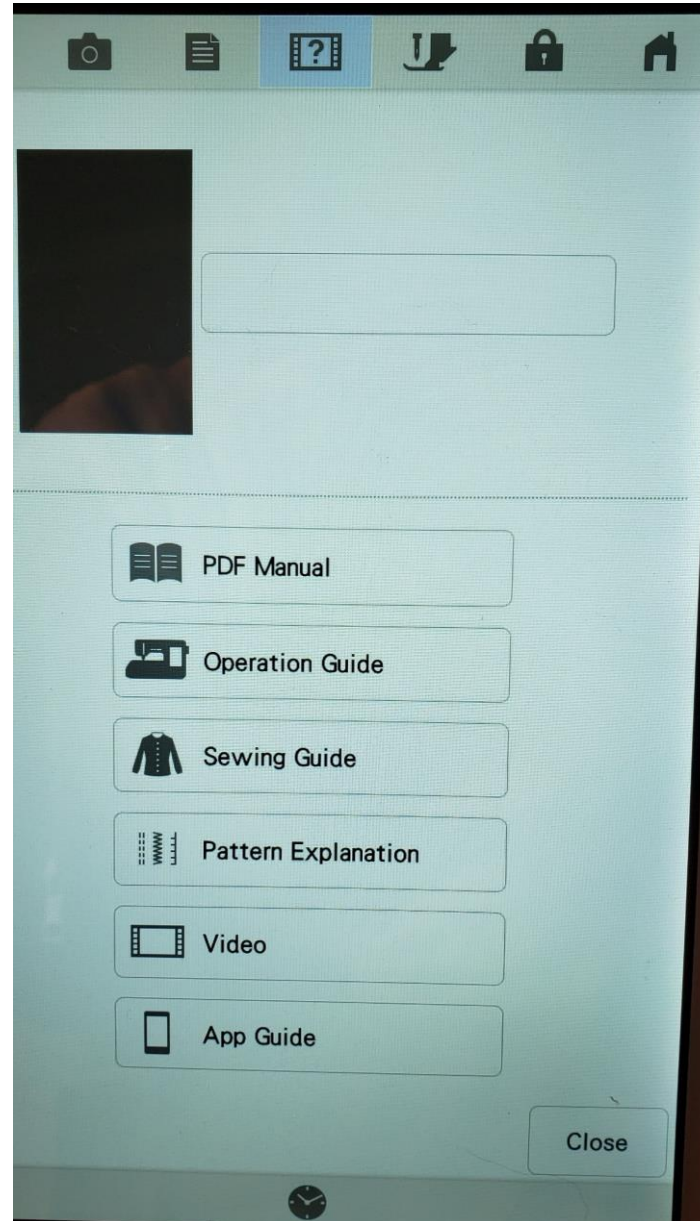


Pattern Explanation

- Choose stitch 1-19
- Press **Sewing Machine Help**
- Touch **Pattern Explanation**
- Use the **right arrow key** to scroll through additional pages and follow the step-by-step instructions for how to sew the stitch
- Press **Return** two times to go back to the main screen
- Touch **OK** to exit

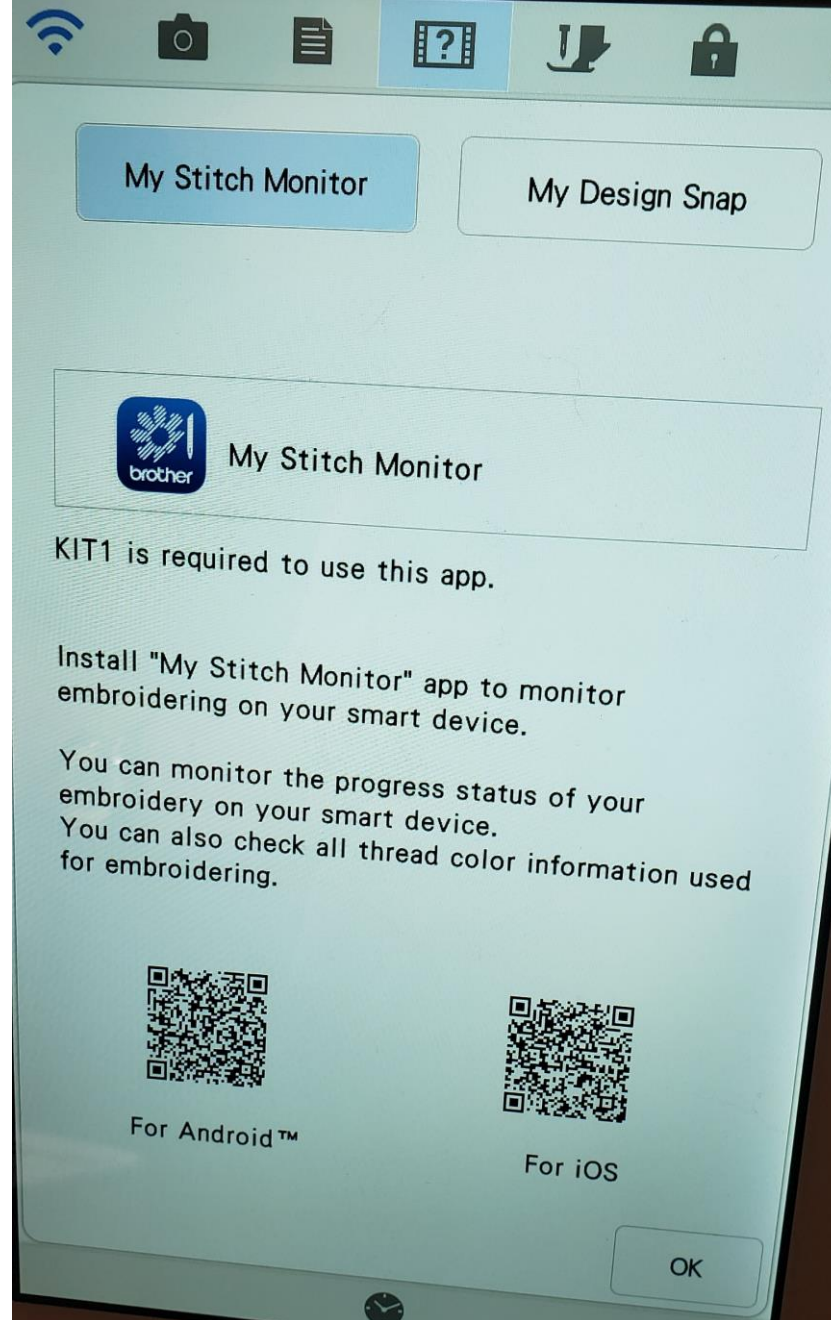
Video

- Choose **Basic Operation**
- Select the video for **Bobbin Winding**
- Press **Play** to watch
- Press **Stop** to end
- Press **Repeat** to watch again
- Press **Close** to return to the video list
- Press **Return** to go back to the main screen
- Touch **OK** to exit

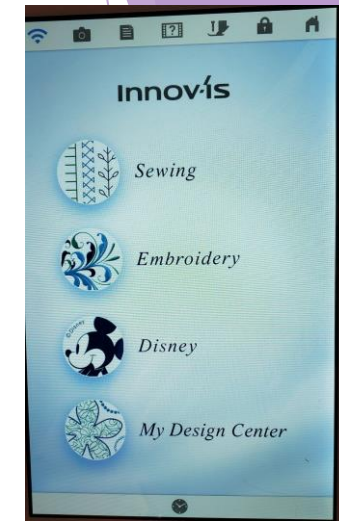


App Guide

- Apps you can get on your phone or tablet.
- My Stitch Monitor keeps track of the progress of your embroidery project.



- **My Design Snap** makes it easy to send pics from your mobile device to your XP2 wirelessly.
- **In the App:**
- Tools icon: tap to verify you are connected to your XP2.
- Under My Design Center, tap “Select image for pattern editing”.
- Choose the image you want to transfer.
- Tap “send to the machine”.

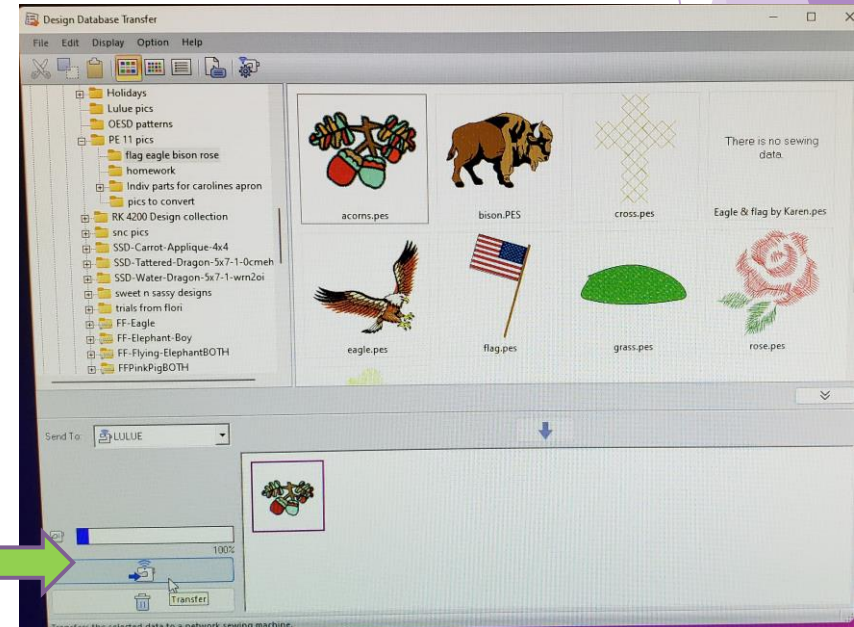
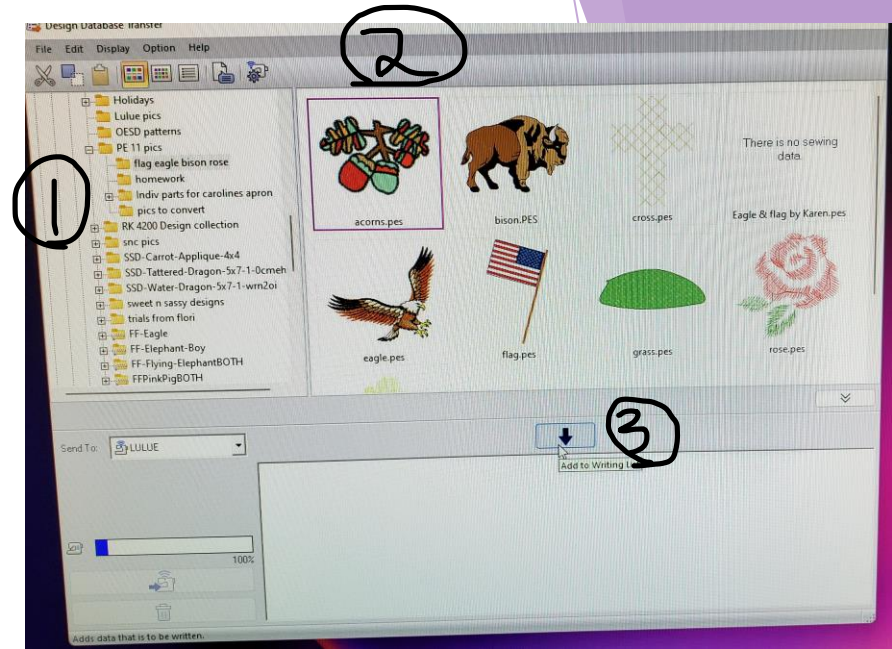


- **Brother Design Database Transfer**

- In the internet search bar of your computer type in “Brother Design Database Transfer”.
- Read the information and tap the box that will take you to the download page.
- Follow the directions from there to download.

- **To use:**

- Find the correct file folder on the left.
- Choose the design.
- Tap the down arrow.
- Tap the icon near the bottom left to send to your XP2.

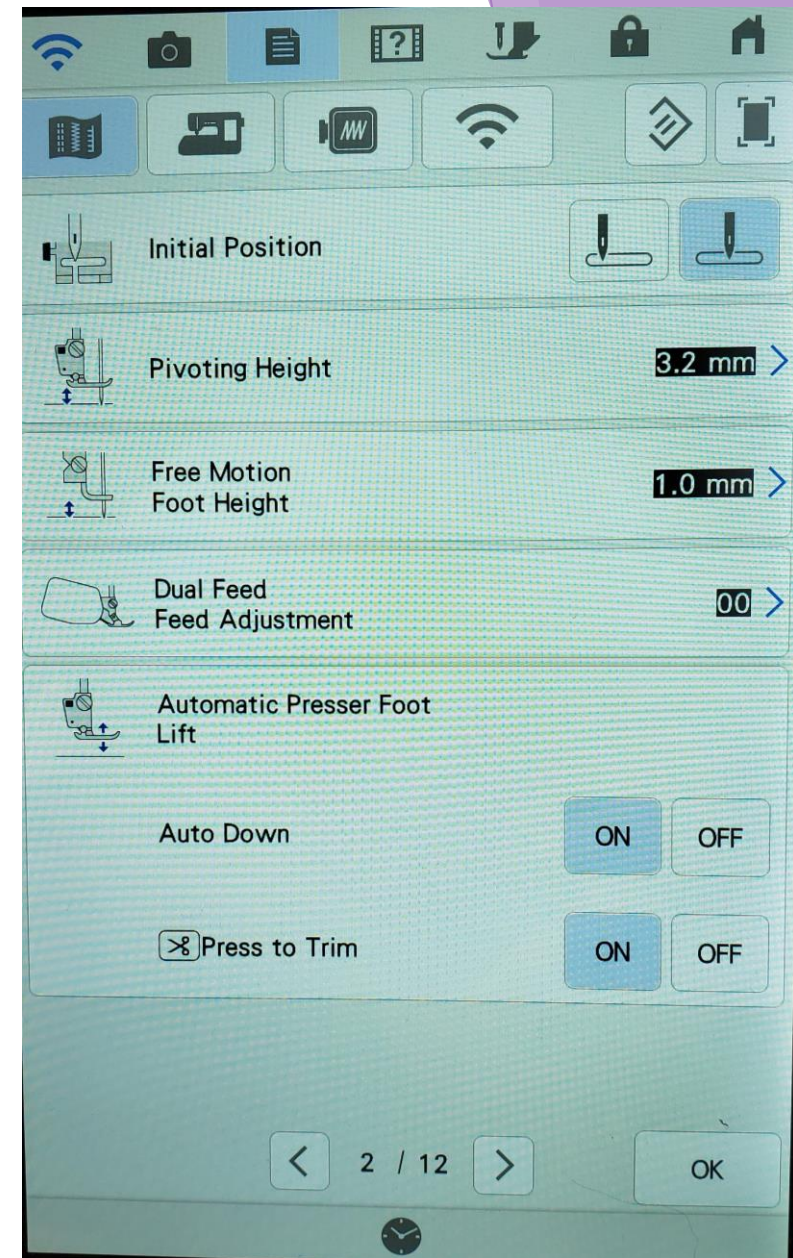
- **Automatic Fabric Sensor System**-the machine will automatically detect the thickness of the fabric and adjust to ensure the fabric is fed smoothly
- **Adjustments and Presser Foot settings** – best to leave at default settings
- **Automatic Fabric Sensor System** - on

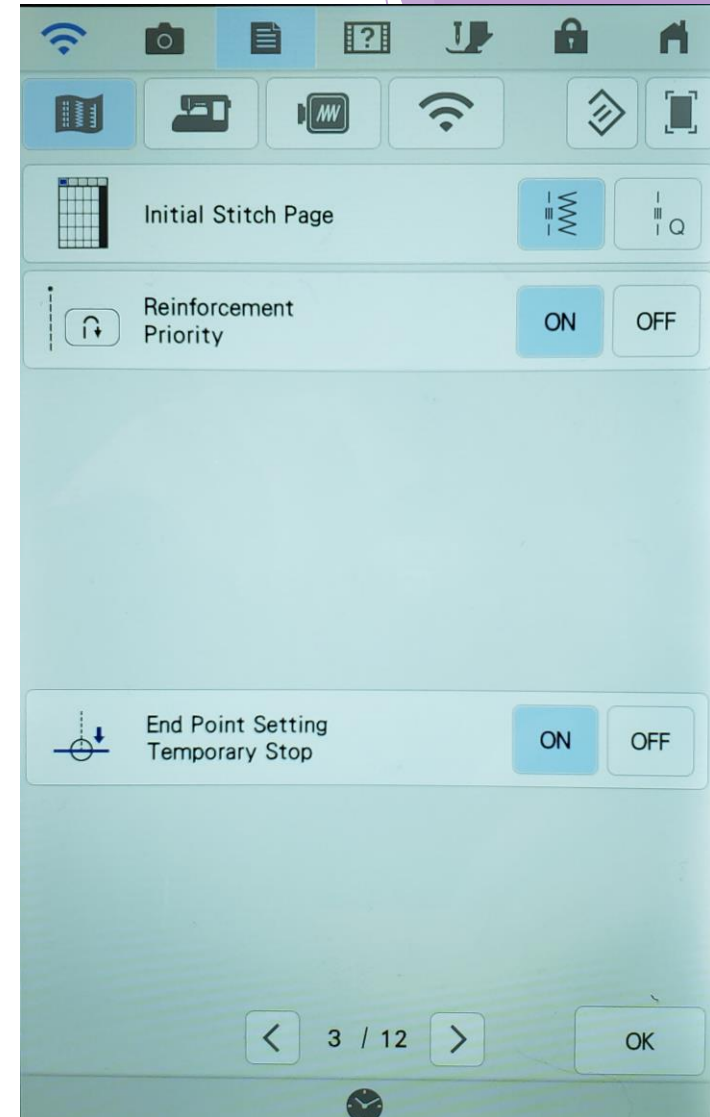
- **Initial Position**-choose between **stitch 1-01** straight stitch, left or **stitch 1-03 straight stitch**, center as the utility stitch that is automatically selected when the machine is turned on
- **Pivoting Height & Free Motion Foot Height:** choose the height at which you prefer your presser foot when pivoting or when using the free motion foot. Default settings are highlighted in black.
- **Automatic Presser Foot Lift** - All functions must be set to ON then the presser foot will go down automatically when the foot control (or go button) is pressed. It will also raise when sewing is done and after a thread cut.



Sewing Settings-

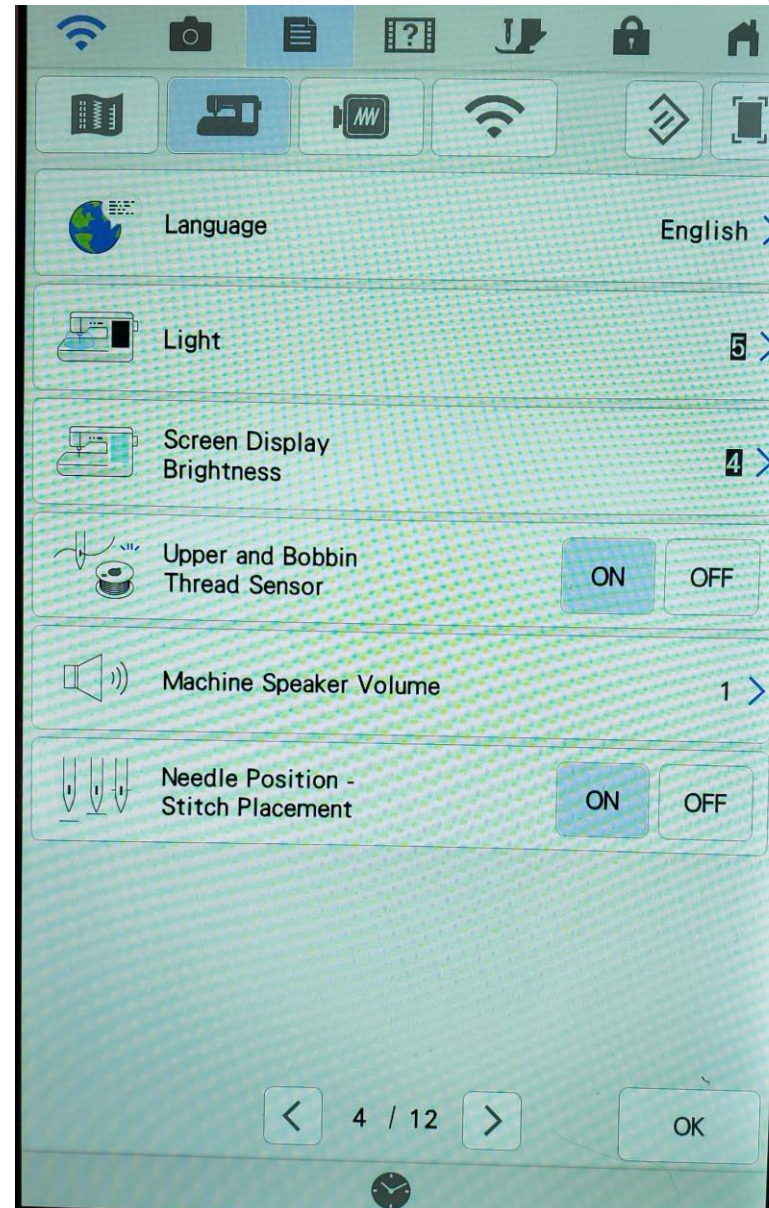
- **Initial Stitch Page**-choose the selection screen that appears when Sewing is pressed on the Home Screen-Utility Stitch or Quilt Stitch
- **Reinforcement Priority:** Choose On
- **End Point Setting:** Choose On

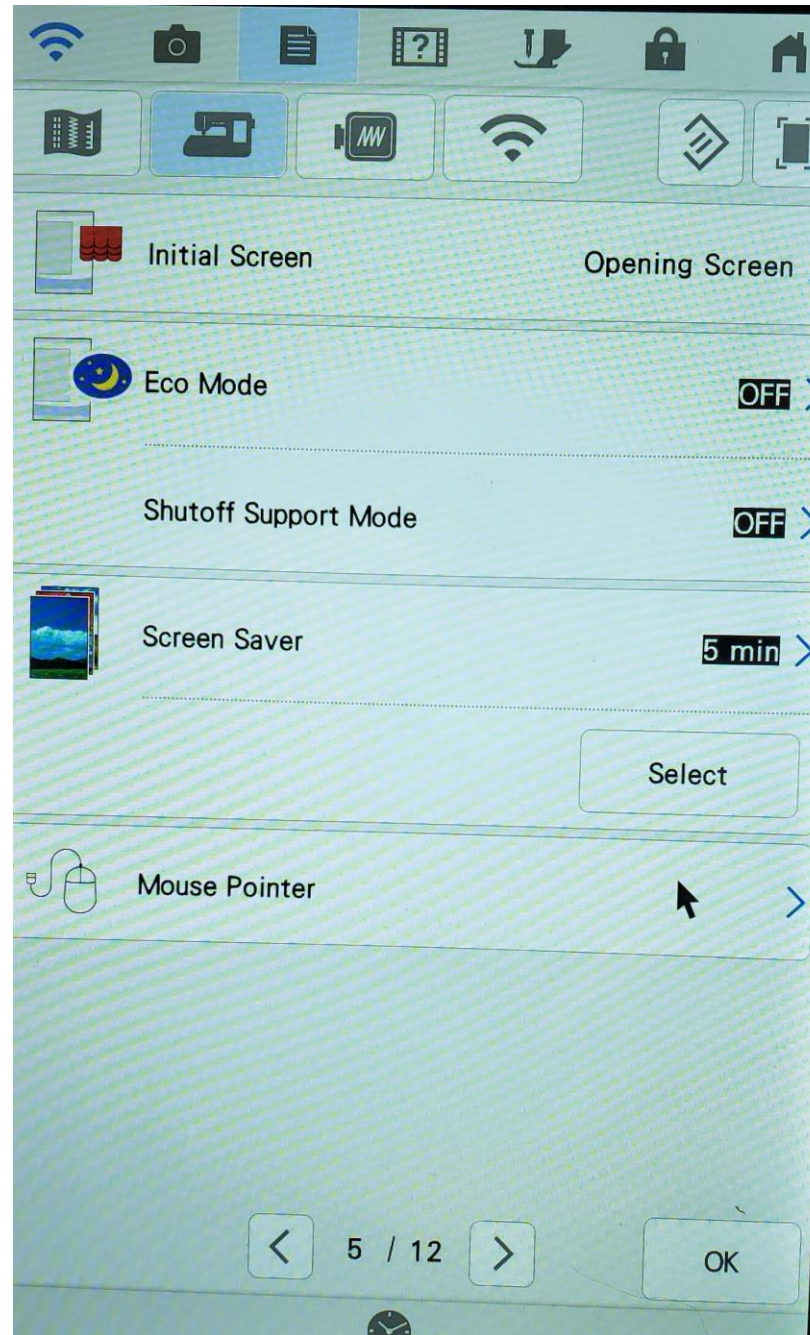
- **Language** - 12 available options
- **Light**
- **Screen Display Brightness**
- **Upper and Bobbin Thread Sensor**- ON
- **Machine Speaker Volume**
- **Needle Position Stitch Placement** - On

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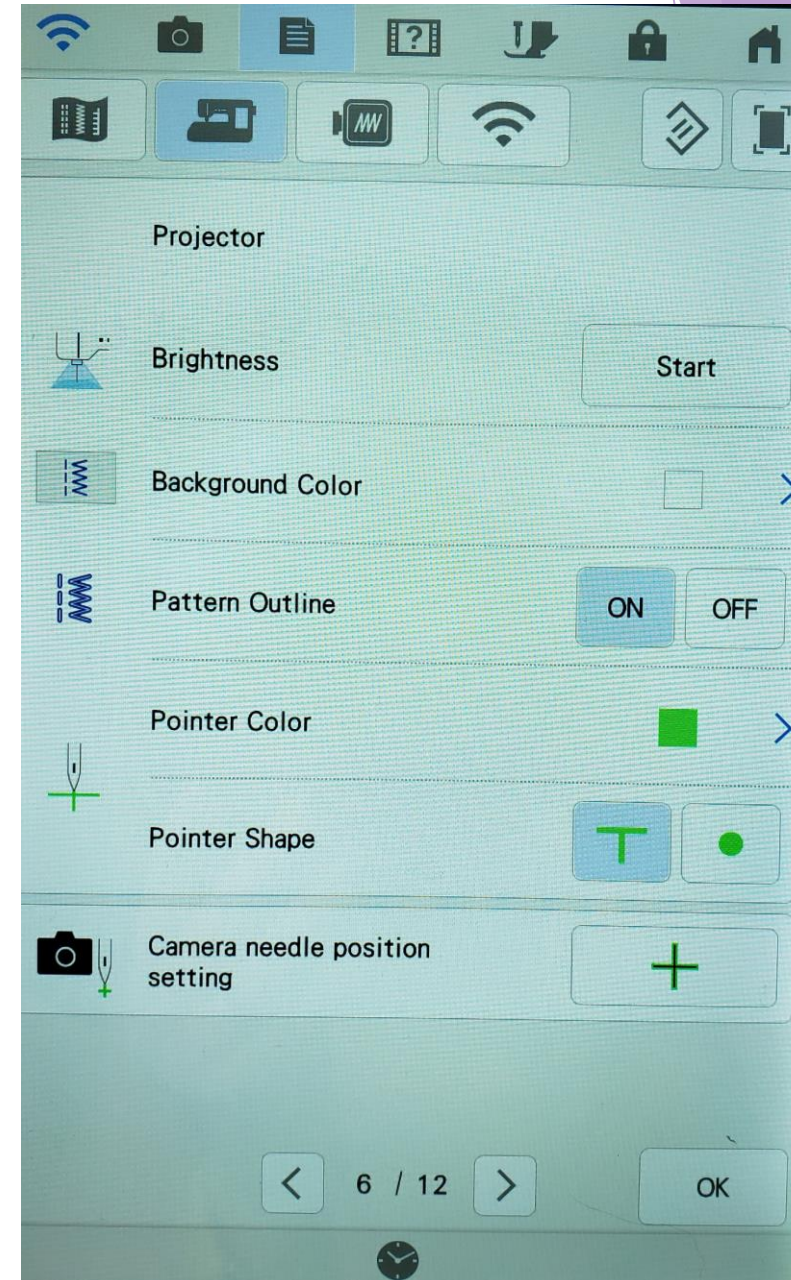

Projector Information

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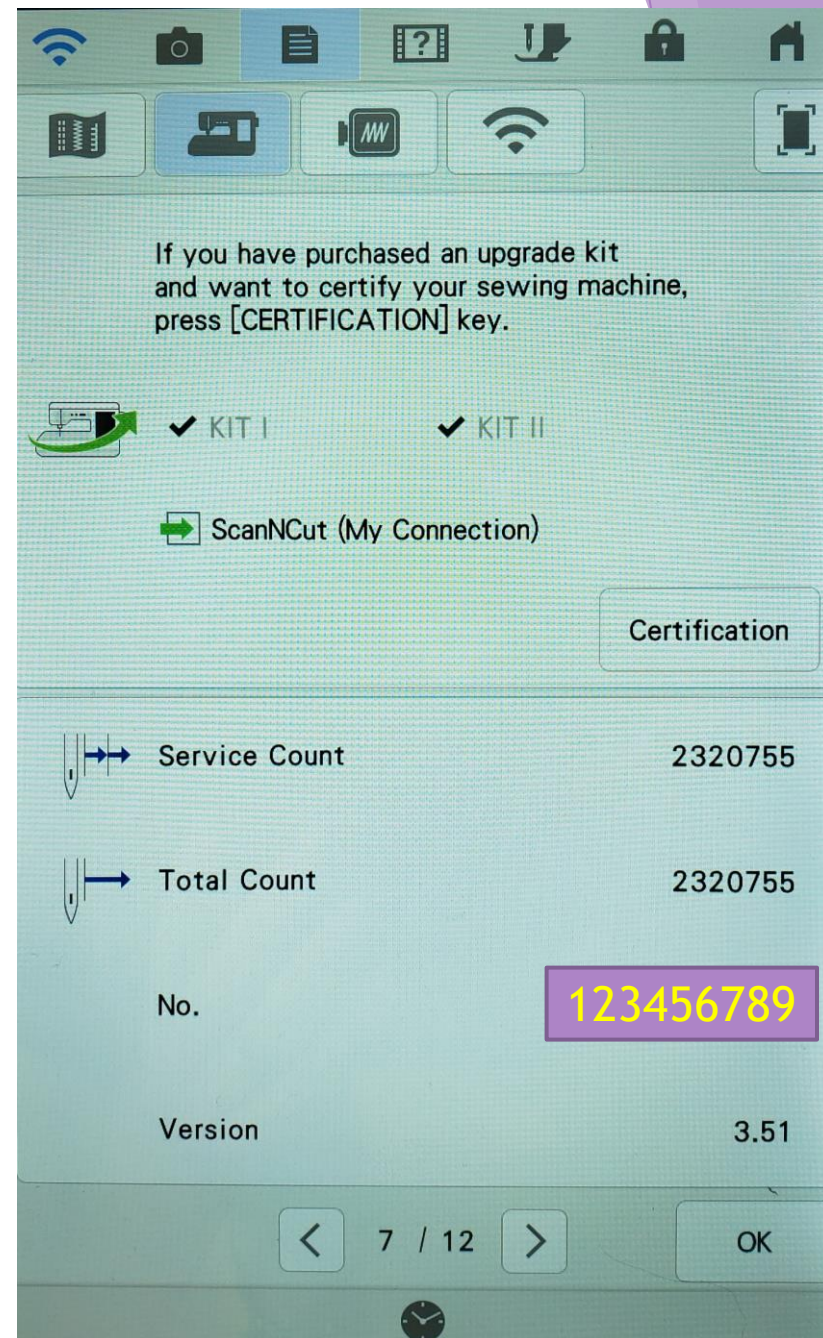
- **Brightness** - levels 1 - 4
- **Background Color** - white, black, gray
- **Pattern Outline** - on
- **Pointer Color** - green, red, black
- **Pointer Shape** - T or circle
- **Camera needle position setting** - calibrates the needle position drop projection

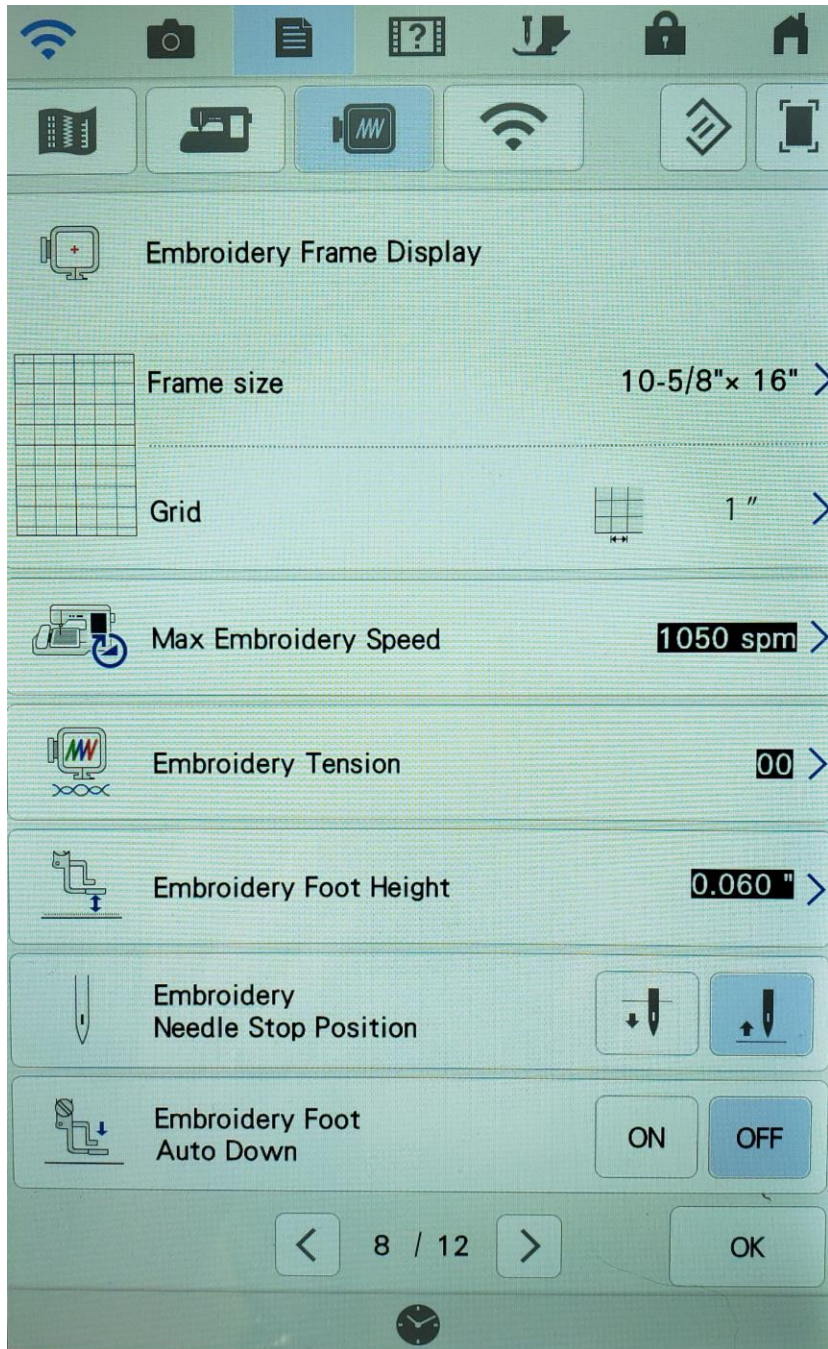


Machine Settings-

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- **Upgrade Kits**
- **Service Count**-how many stitches are on the machine since the last servicing
- **Total Count** – total number of stitches on the machine
- **Machine Number**
- **Version**-check here to be sure you have the latest update





Embroidery Settings-

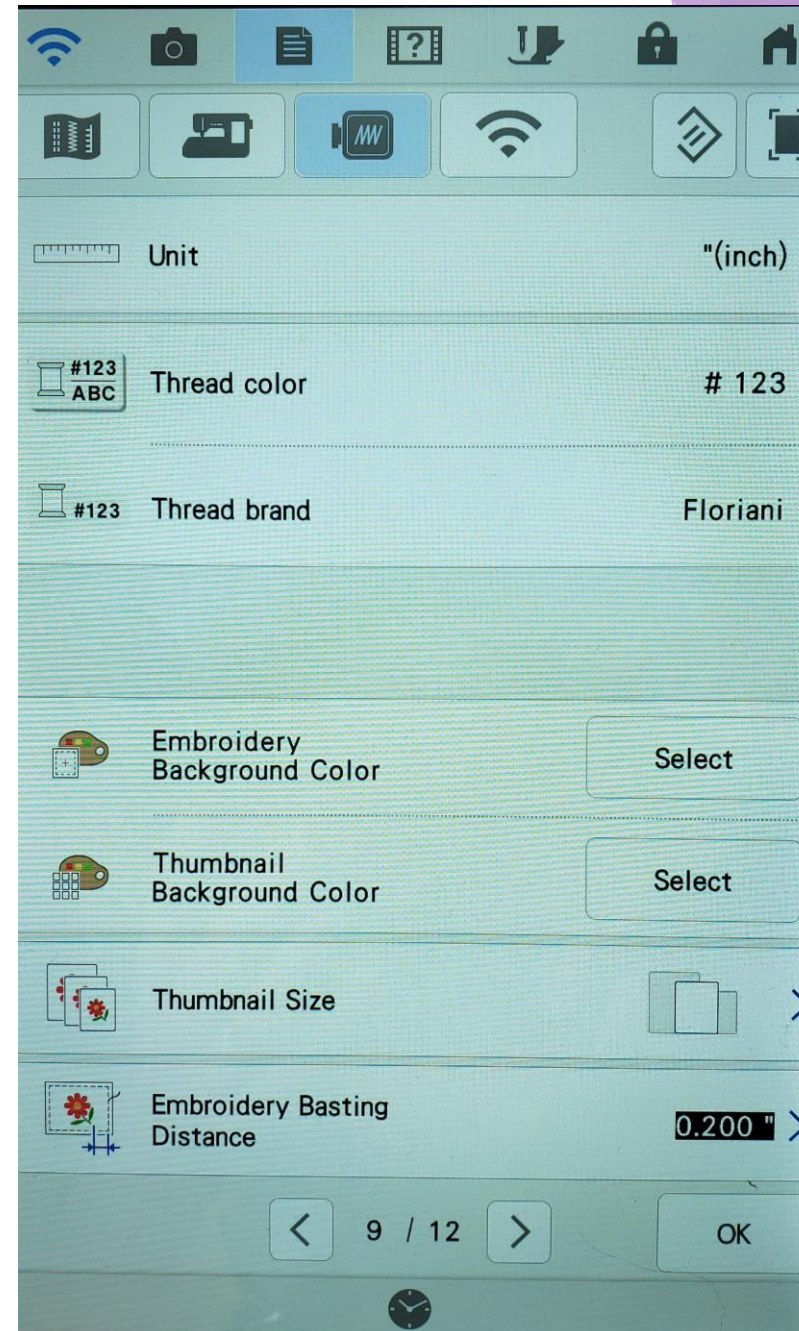

- **Embroidery Frame Display**-Hoop Size, grid size
- **Max Embroidery Speed**-1050 is the fastest
- **Embroidery Tension** - **Don't touch: job for Technician**
- **Embroidery Foot Height**
- **Embroidery Needle stop position** – up or down
- **Embroidery Foot Auto Down**

Embroidery Settings

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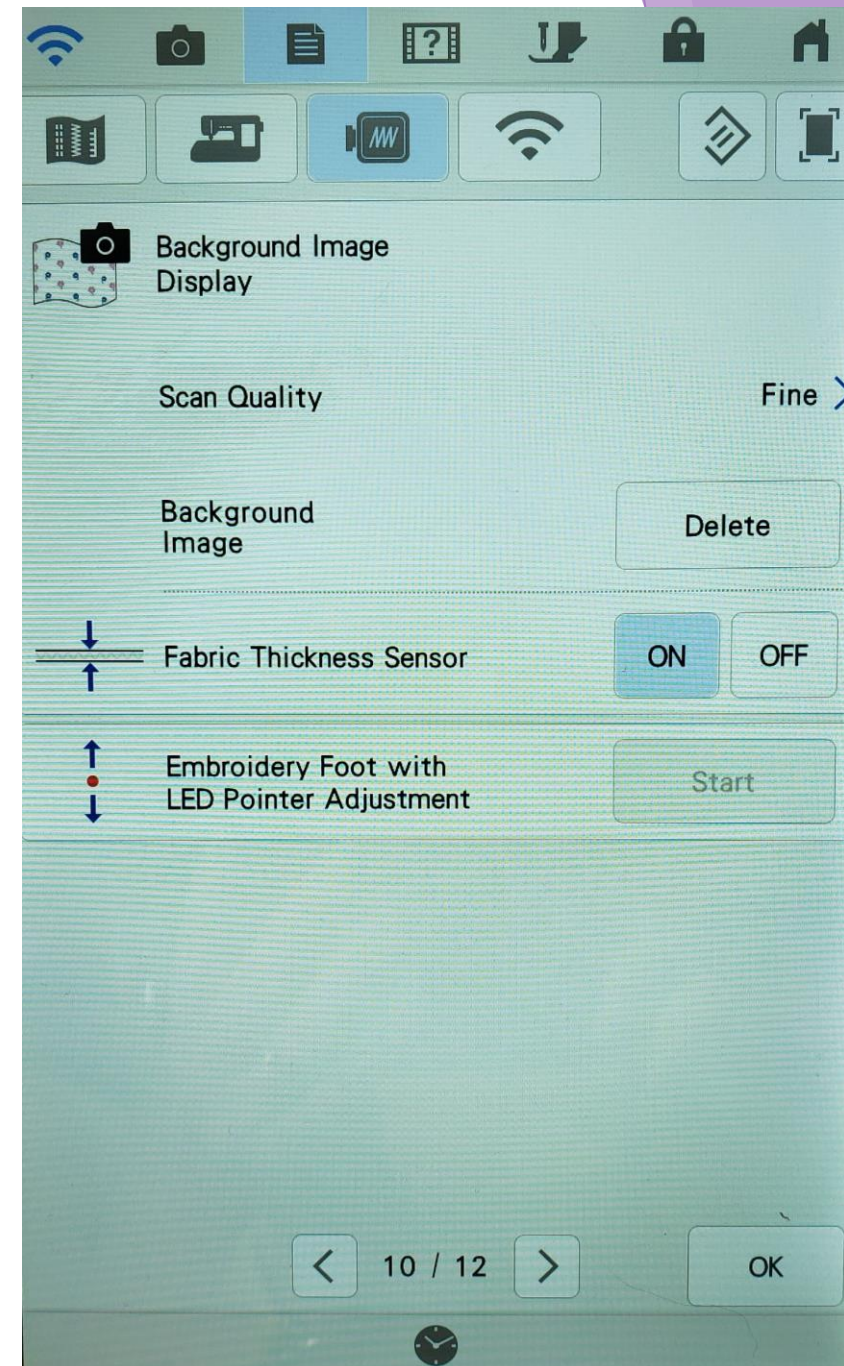
- **Unit** - toggle between millimeters and inches
- **Thread Color Display** - by name or number, some brands
- **Thread brand** - choose the brand you're using.
- **Embroidery Background color**
- **Thumbnail Background color**
- **Thumbnail Size**
- **Embroidery Basting Distance**-the higher the setting, the farther the basting is from the pattern



Scanner Settings

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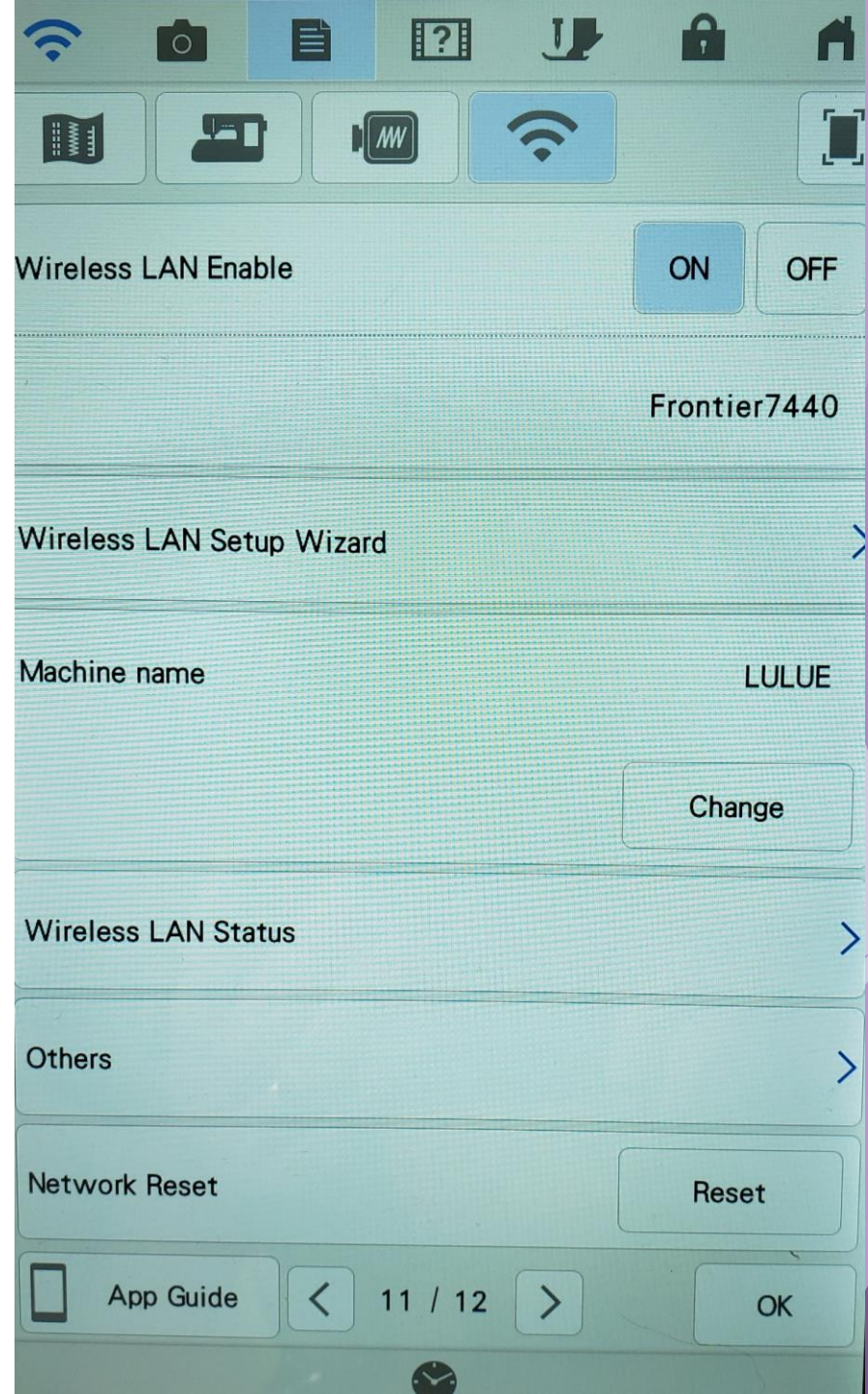
- **Background Image Display** - Press the **Delete** key to clear your screen after you have scanned (otherwise, your most recent scan will show up as background the next time you go to My Design Center).
- **Automatic Fabric Sensor System** - the machine will automatically detect the thickness of the fabric and adjust to ensure the fabric is fed smoothly.
- **Embroidery Foot with LED Pointer Adjustment**



Network Settings

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- **Wireless LAN Enable** - on to set up wireless at home
- **Wireless LAN Setup Wizard** - walks through the setup
- **Machine Name** - have fun! Give it a name!
- **Wireless LAN Status**

- **Auto Download** - when on will update by itself
- **Update manually**
